The Davis County Community Foundation was formed in 2005 to coordinate and provide philanthropic support for community betterment projects in Davis County. Each year the foundation makes grant awards to worthwhile projects located in the county that are identified through a community grants application process. The Foundation, by code of Iowa, makes grants to I.R.S. 501c(3) 'tax exempt' organizations and 170(b) 'unit of government' organizations to assist in fulfilling the Foundation's mission to *foster private giving, strengthen service providers and improve the conditions of the community, county, or area of interest*. Our foundation promotes endowment building, community grant making, organizational collaboration, and public leadership for the benefit of the Davis County area. If your organization is not a 501c3 or government entity, you need to partner with one.

The Foundation is an affiliate of the Iowa Community Affiliate Network, a collaboration of the Greater Des Moines Community Foundation (GDMCF) and the Iowa Area Development Group Community Foundation, who have recognized the need for new avenues to encourage philanthropy throughout Iowa. The Iowa Community Affiliate Network currently serves 31 counties throughout Iowa, including an "umbrella" or "Family" of related funds benefiting specific communities and projects. Each Affiliate advises on a geographically focused collection of funds. They are components of the GDMCF sharing in its tax-exempt status and developed to increase the philanthropic base for Davis County.

Grant amounts are dependent upon the allocation of funds available to the Community Foundation each fiscal year, limited to non-profits located in and projects serving the county and include any grant limits or restrictions as announced.
